



SkillsUSA Kentucky Advisor of the Year Criteria

This award will be presented to a secondary (high school) and/or postsecondary (collegiate) educator involved in technical, skilled, and service occupations and who has achieved prominence at the local, state or national level. This award will be presented annually at the state SkillsUSA Kentucky Leadership Conference and Skill Championship.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible individuals are individuals who are currently employed by area technology centers, high schools, career centers, postsecondary institutions teaching Career and Technical Education. Contributions and achievements, on which the nomination is based, should have been made within the past ten years. The nominee must be a paid Professional Member of SkillsUSA.

There will be three possible categories 1) an advisor who has three years or less in teaching, 2) an advisor who has over three years teaching secondary students, 3) an advisor who has over three years teaching post-secondary students.
