

## **Clothing Addendum to National SkillsUSA Technical Standards for Kentucky State Contests**

1. Judges will accept official SkillsUSA dress OR clothing that meets the criteria below for regional and state contests in Kentucky.
  - A. Official SkillsUSA dress may be replaced by similar items without logos.
    1. For example, the white SkillsUSA polo may be replaced by a white polo that has no logo or branding.
    2. For example, the blue SkillsUSA shirt (required in Automotive Service Technology and other such contests) can be replaced by a light blue button-up shirt that has no logo or branding.
  - B. Shoes, socks and belt requirements remain the same.
  - C. Clothing must be clean and free from holes and tears.

**NOTE: Official dress is still required for the state conference Opening and Closing sessions. Remember that red jackets, black Carhart blazers and wind breakers that have the VICA, SkillsUSA/VICA or SkillsUSA emblem still qualify as official dress.**

**BE ADVISED that this addendum does NOT change the requirement for students to wear official SkillsUSA clothing for national conference.**

## **Class A: SkillsUSA Official Dress**

**For Men:** Official SkillsUSA Blazer or jacket, **OR black Carhart blazers**; black dress slacks; white dress shirt; plain black tie with no pattern (or SkillsUSA black tie); black socks; black shoes.

**For Women:** Official SkillsUSA Blazer or jacket; black dress skirt (knee-length) or black slacks; plain business-like white, collarless blouse (or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer); black sheer or skin-tone hose; black shoes.

## **Class B: Healthcare Attire**

**For both Men and Women:** Official blue scrubs Or blue scrubs without SkillsUSA or other logos (fitted – including hemming and wrinkle-free); only plain white collarless tees underneath; white socks or skin-tone seamless hose; health-professional’s clean white leather work shoes. Shoes must be all-white leather (no canvas), completely enclosed (no open-toe or open heel) with clean laces. Athletic style shoes that meet the criteria mentioned previously are acceptable.

**Jewelry:** One stud or a small hoop in each ear is acceptable. Wedding bands may be worn, however there should be no exposed stone (if there is a stone, it must be taped). No facial or tongue rings.

**Tattoos:** Visible tattoos must be covered including hands, arms, neck, etc.

**For both Men and Women:** Official SkillsUSA khaki work shirt and pants **Or Khaki work shirt and pants without SkillsUSA or other logos** ; black, brown, or tan leather work shoes; safety glasses with side shields or goggles (prescription glasses may be used, only if they are equipped with side shields. If not, they must be covered with goggles).

**For Both Men and Women:** Official SkillsUSA light blue work shirt; navy pants **Or light blue work shirt; navy pants without SkillsUSA or other logos**; black, brown, or tan leather work shoes. Safety glasses with side shields or goggles (prescription glasses may be used only if they are equipped with side shields. If not, they must be covered with goggles).

## Class E: Business Casual

**For Men:** Official SkillsUSA white polo shirt; black dress slacks **Or white polo shirt; black dress slacks without SkillsUSA or other logos;** black socks; black leather shoes.

**For Women:** Official SkillsUSA white polo shirt with black dress skirt (knee-length) or black slacks **Or white polo shirt with black dress skirt (knee-length) or black slacks without SkillsUSA or other logos,** black socks or black or skin-tone seamless hose; black leather dress shoes.

## **Class F: Cosmetology/Esthetics/Nail Care Attire**

**For Men:** Official SkillsUSA white dress shirt; black dress slacks **Or white dress shirt; black dress slacks without SkillsUSA or other logos**; black socks; black leather work or dress shoes.

**For Women:** Official white top; black dress slacks **Or white top; black dress slacks without SkillsUSA or other logos**; black socks or black or skin-tone seamless hose; black leather work or dress shoes.

**Note:** A white cosmetology smock can be worn with the white dress shirt for men or white top for women.

## **Class G: Culinary/Commercial Baking Attire**

**For both Men and Women:** White or black work pants or black-and-white checkered chef's pants\*, white chef's jacket **OR White or black work pants or black-and-white checkered chef's pants Without SkillsUSA or other logos\***, white chef's jacket **OR white chef's jacket Without SkillsUSA or other logos**, white or black leather work shoes; white apron **OR white apron Without SkillsUSA or other logos**; white neckerchief; side-towels; hairnet. Chef's hats (toques) will be supplied by the National Technical Committee, as well as food-handlers' gloves.

## Class H: Restaurant Service

**For Men:** Official SkillsUSA white long-sleeved dress shirt, or long-sleeved plain white collared shirt; black dress slacks with belt; plain black tie with no pattern or SkillsUSA black tie; black socks; shined black leather work shoes.

**For Women:** Official SkillsUSA white long-sleeved dress shirt, or long-sleeved plain white collared shirt; black skirt (knee-length) or black dress slacks with belt; black socks or black or skin-colored seamless hose; shined black flat heels.

**Note:** *Bistro aprons are the official apron for Restaurant Service and are not optional. Waiter's jackets, bow ties, vests, cummerbunds, or half aprons are not permitted.*

**Note:** The national guideline allow for non SkillsUSA logos on clothing.



## Class I – Welding/Welding Fabrication

**For Both Men and Women:** Official SkillsUSA khaki work shirt and pants OR khaki work shirt and pants Without SkillsUSA or other logos (both the pants and the shirt must be 100% cotton); black, brown, or tan leather work shoes; safety glasses with side shields or goggles (prescription glasses can be worn only if they are equipped with side shields. If not, they must be covered with goggles).
